ORDER

NO. SO(DM)ACE-840/2022. WHEREAS, the undersigned as Competent Authority under the Punjab Employees Efficiency, Discipline & Accountability Act, 2006, is of the opinion that there are sufficient grounds to proceed against the **Mr. Sher Baaz Ahmad, Assistant Professor (BS-18)**/ ex-Deputy Director Colleges, Pakpattan presently posted as **Deputy Director Colleges, Okara** under Section 3 of the Act ibid on account of following charges of misconduct, inefficiency, corruption and corrupt practices under Section 3 of the PEEDA Act, 2006. Detail is as under:

- i. He obtained an amount of **Rs.4,00,000/-** illegally as a loan from Govt. Farida Graduate College, Pakpattan and refused to repay.
- ii. He installed an Air Conditioner in his office illegally and taken over an amount of **Rs.3,50,000/-** from the funds from the Govt. Farida Graduate College, Pakpattan on account of electricity bills.
- iii. He embezzled the scholarship funds and not issued cheques to the students who completed their academic session during his whole tenure w.e.f 2019 to 2022.
- iv. He is prime facie responsible of an untoward incident took place on 24.11.2022 due to his unprofessional attitude which incited the students who staged a protest before the DDC Office/ Govt. Farida Graduate College, Pakpattan and halted the educational activities and un-functional of DDC office. The incident was reported both in national newspapers and electronic media.

2. **AND WHEREAS**, I consider that in the light of facts of the case and in the interest of justice, it is necessary to hold an inquiry. I, therefore, appointed Muhammad Shazad Rafiq, Principal (BS-20) as Inquiry Officer under Section 5 read with section 9 of the Act ibid and to conduct inquiry into the above mentioned charges as mentioned against each accused.


3. **AND WHEREAS**, the accused officers / officials are directed to submit their written defence to the Inquiry Officer, **within seven (07) days** of the date of receipt of this order. If they fail to submit their written defence within the prescribed period, it shall be presumed that either they have no defence to offer or they have declined to offer the same and they have accepted the charges.

4. **Director of Education Colleges, Sahiwal** is appointed as Departmental Representative in terms of Section 9(1)(c) read with Section 12 of the Act ibid.

5. In case the accused officers / officials desire to consult any record on which the aforesaid charge(s) is based or is relevant to the aforesaid charge(s), they may do so with prior

arrangement with the undersigned or the Departmental Representative within 07 days of the receipt of this order.

6. The Inquiry Officer shall submit his report and recommendations to the undersigned within sixty (60) days of the initiation of inquiry in terms of Section 10(6) of the Act ibid.
